Stakeholders and Materiality

In 2017, LC Packaging defined its material sustainability topics based on the input of our most important stakeholders. This process included a comprehensive materiality assessment, in which we consulted and partnered with our stakeholders and started a dialogue about what it takes to establish a sustainable future for us all. In short, we took the following steps:

- Our Board of Directors and leaders defined a vision and strategic goals. One of these goals: To become a leader in sustainability;
- Our employees were consulted on sustainability topics that are important to them, using surveys and interactive sessions;
- Our Production Partners were asked to sign our Supplier Code of Conduct and consulted on their sustainability goals and vision, and asked to join forces and make sustainability a supply chain effort;
- Our customers were interviewed and asked: How can LC Packaging contribute to your goals?
- Community ambassadors were consulted to identify the need for local communities to be able to secure a safe and healthy future for next generations to enjoy;
- Using the Global Sustainable Development Goals, we identified our impact on the global sustainability agenda.

Based on the valuable input of our stakeholders, we identified 4 so-called areas of commitment, covering a total of 14 material topics. These topics represent the highest priority indicators to our stakeholders. Each material topic is linked to a 2022 goal.

Our sustainability strategy is documented in our [Sustainability Vision 2022: No Time To Waste](#). Our stakeholders are involved, consulted and informed throughout the process of achieving our goals. In other words, we cannot achieve our goals without our stakeholders. Sustainability is a supply chain effort.







